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Tips and Ideas: 7 Tips to Boost Your Child's Speech

- 1. Describe Everything: Explain. Describe everything around you. Why, Where, Who, What, and how.
- 2. Ask Questions: Even if they can't respond yet, ask the questions. Then model how to answer.
- 3. Tell Stories: Get their imagination going.
- 4. Be Positive: Make speaking fun and positive.
- 5. Avoid Baby Talk: Use simple but real language. They understand more than you think.
- 6. Gesture Mode: Non-verbal communication helps a child's understanding too.
- 7. Stop and Listen: Give them a chance to respond and reply.
